Discussion Topics:

1. Roll call and welcome new member, Alexis Clark to our committee.
2. Decide how many absences warrant dropping someone from committee. NOTE: The PSA General Assembly by-laws say if someone misses 4 meetings in 12 months without an alternate or proxy representative attending for the member, then they can be dropped from membership.
3. Re-cap Minutes from May 13, 2006 Meeting and make any corrections.
4. Discuss United Way "Day of Action" workday set for Sat. June 21st from 9AM-4PM. No one besides me on our committee has volunteered to my knowledge. See www.uwwa.org for registration form in case someone is interested. Deadline to register is this Friday, May 30th.
5. Discuss what community or service projects or social events that we would like to help with or create ourselves such as one or more of the following:
 - a. Assist United Way or one of its 26 service agencies somehow this year or next. See a list of those 26 agencies at www.uwwa.org
 - b. Assist Red Cross or United Blood Services in setting-up a blood drive on campus.
 - c. Assist as volunteers at the October 22, 2008 UA Employee Health Fair at Coleman Coliseum.
 - d. Identify some type of "green project" on or off campus like:
 - 1) Starting re-cycling in a new area, or
 - 2) Helping set-up a new pedestrian walkway or path, or
 - 3) Indentify where more UA trash receptacles are needed on campus.
6. Help with the "Beat Hunger/Beat Auburn" campaign this fall.
7. Help with the United Way campaign this fall.
8. Help UA with its new Capitol Funds campaign this fall.
9. Maybe set-up some sub-committees with minimum of 3 members to work on a project.

That's it for now, but we can add, delete or amend the above agenda items as we deem appropriate.

Please try and come on June 6th. Some of you have already e-mailed me saying that you will be working or will be out of town that day, so ask for someone to be your proxy to come and listen if nothing else.

I know that we are all open to new ideas, so come prepared to brainstorm on June 6th, and then we can use the off month of July 2008 to prioritize the proposed projects in our mind so that when we return in August 2008 then we can hopefully finalize our projects with goals and objectives on how to achieve them.
